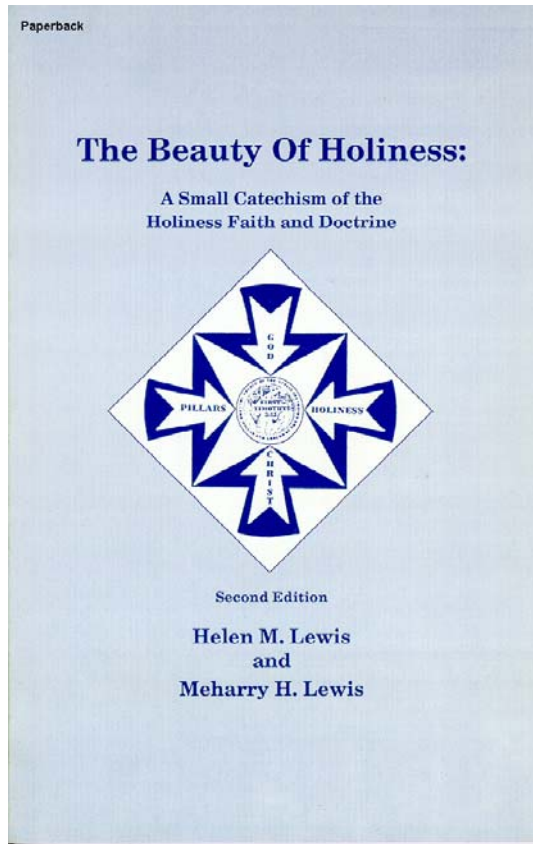

This book documents for some and introduces to others, the faith and doctrine of the church founded by Mary Lena Lewis Tate in 1903.

Mary Lena Lewis Tate (1871-1930) is the Founder and First Chief Overseer of the international religious organization, *The Church of the Living God, the Pillar and Ground of the Truth, Inc.* (1903). She is recognized as the first black matriarch to found an international religious organization; and perhaps the second female to head such an organization in the United States. The volume contains a total of fourteen chapters and includes the theological concepts of the organization as espoused by the Founder. The small book (109 pages) is catalogued under such sought-after titles as, Holiness Faith and Doctrine, Pentecostal churches, women preachers, female clergy, black leaders, church leaders, and a myriad of other cogent titles and subject headings.
